1. There are hungry people in the world
2. Hunger is responsible for more deaths than which three global health issues combined?
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3. How is hunger linked to climate change? Explain in your own words
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4. A lot of the food that we consume is not sustainable (Sustainable means that we can continue to produce or use something at the same rate for as long as we need to). How does the food that we consume create Carbon Dioxide (CO₂) emissions?
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5. Each year tonnes of food are wasted
6. What is one thing you can do to take action on this issue of food waste, which is contributing to climate change?
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7. In your opinion, how difficult do you think that it will be for individuals and communities to take action on food waste? What would make it easier for people?
