Could provide families with a 5kg bag of fortified flour every month for a year. This flour is normally distributed during the 'lean season'. This is when food from the last harvest has run out, but the next crops are not ready to eat. This period can sometimes last for up to five months.

Could provide five goats. Goats are able to survive harsher climates, they're more resilient and provide great support for families and their livelihoods.



Can provide drought resistant seeds along with training for 10 farmers in vital conservation farming techniques proven to withstand extreme weather conditions.
