
THE POOREST AND MOST VULNERABLE ARE BEING AFFECTED THE MOST



IN 2017, ARCTIC SEA ICE reached a record low for the third straight year running





Concern and Climate Change:



Over 120,000 people have benefited from resilience and risk mitigation work within vulnerable communities in Bangladesh



Concern has supported 780,227 farmers with Climate Smart Agriculture livelihood programmes since 2016



In response to the impact of Climate Change on communities in the Global South, Concern has introduced agroforestry to 65 target villages in the Sila region of Chad, promoting fruit tree production while regenerating wider ecosystems
